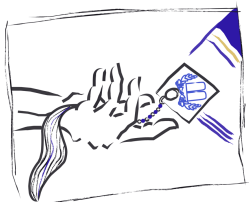

Messianic				Relating to or having the qualities of a Messiah – in our case, Yeshua						
Tzedakah	צדקה	Charity		"Justice" or "righteousness" - commonly used to signify charity Different concept from charity: Tzedakah is an obligation and charity is typically understood as a spontaneous act of goodwill and a marker of generosity						
Shlichim	שליחים	Apostles		Plural for "sent one" or "Emmissary" ("Shaliach" שליח) – Comes from the word "Shalach" = "to send"

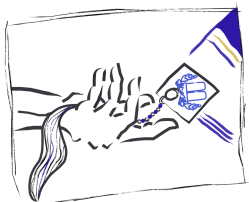

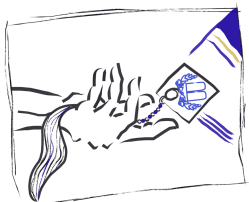
