Our mission

Romans 15:16:

Our vision

To be a community of Believers living a Chasidic lifestyle consistent with Messianic Judaism of the First Century, in loving obedience to our Rabbi Yeshua HaMashiach, so as to hasten the day of the Geulah (His return and the redemption of all Israel).

Goals

Short to medium term:

- Establish a house of Messianic learning to teach authentic Messianic Judaism (that is, to teach the Word of G-d in its original framework of Judaism), open to both Gentiles and Jews
- Enable Believers to embrace a lifestyle consistent with Messianic Judaism of the First Century C.E., through these teachings (it is not expected that all students of Derech HaMashiach will embrace every aspect of this lifestyle)
- Make available a branch of Yeshivat Shuvu for those who wish to learn the deeper principles of Messianic Judaism

Medium to long term:

- Establish a Torah Service based on Messianic Judaism, so that those who have the heart knowledge and desire can begin to participate in this form of worship, in unity with the people of Israel
- Establish a community of Believers that will be in fellowship with each other and embrace those outside the community that wish to know more about the G-d that this community serves and worships (it is not expected that every student of Derech HaMashiach will become a member of this community)
- To hasten the Geulah, the redemption of G-d's people, through the coming of Messiah, by living a lifestyle over and above what we are obliged to according to Torah (Chasidism), regardless of whether we are Jew or Gentile by birth
- Continue the House of Messianic Learning, available to all those that are serious about learning the Word of G-d from this context, regardless of their religious affiliation

Our Associations

Yeshivat Shuvu

Ralf has been a student of the Yeshiva, and talmid (disciple) of Rabbi Itzhak Shapira since 2015. The Yeshiva has grown exponentially over those years with over 400 talmidim in 27 countries. The primary goal of the Yeshiva is not just to provide people with knowledge, but ultimately to equip disciples with the proper framework and practical tools from the Torah, the Disciples, and ultimately Yeshua himself, to make an impact on the world around them.



Rabbi Shapira serves as the Rosh (head of) Yeshiva. He is a fully ordained Rabbi (under IAMCS) and after studying the Rabbinic Jewish texts for many years, he found the Messiah in the Hebrew Writings.

Rabbi Shapira is an inspiration to everyone who not only wants to learn about Messianic Judaism, but also those who aspire to walk in the Ways of HaShem, and His Messiah. His knowledge of Torah, both Written and Oral, and the Apostolic Writings is simply awe inspiring, and his constant challenge to not just learn, but to live what we have learned, speaks of the heart of our ultimate Rabbi, Yeshua HaMashiach.

Other lecturers in the Yeshiva are Rabbi Steven Bernstein (Rabbi at Aydat HaDerekh Messianic Synagogue in Fort Myers, Florida) and Pastor Raúl Rubio (Pastor and founder of Yoel Messianic Foundation in Bogotá, Colombia, who also heads the Spanish branch of the Yeshiva).

Ahavat Ammi

Rabbi Shapira is also the founding Rabbi of Ahavat Ammi Ministries, an international Jewish Organisation focused on reconciliation between Jews and Yeshua. Ralf and Marie not only support this ministry financially, but also highly recommend all the teaching available from Rabbi Shapira through this website. In particular they recommend the book authored by Rabbi Shapira titled "The Return of the Kosher Pig". This book is a fascinating insight into Judaism, some of its shortcomings, but especially how Judaism understood the anticipated Messiah 2000 years ago and how that picture so perfectly fits the story of Yeshua of Nazareth.

Aydat HaDerekh Messianic Synagogue

After pursuing Jewish studies all his life, Rabbi Bernstein was finally ordained in 2010 and has taken over leadership of Aydat HaDerekh Messianic Synagogue. Rabbi Bernstein is also a professor at Shuvu Yeshiva and received Smicha there in December 2014. In 2015 Rabbi Bernstein received Smicha from the International Association of Messianic Congregations and Synagogues (IAMCS). Rabbi Bernstein is another amazing Jewish Rabbi who has found Yeshua in Judaism without having to compromise his practice of Judaism, in fact Yeshua only adds to it.

Who do we relate to:

Asia Region

Yeshivat Shuvu has over 30 ministry leaders from all over the globe, who relate to each other. In Australia our closest neighbours are our fellow talmidim in Asia. The leadership of Derech HaMashiach relate to a number of the Asian leadership through regular Torah Studies, annual conferences and quarterly leadership video conferencing. Ralf and Marie met with Rabbi Shapira and the Asian leaders at the first annual conference in Singapore in early 2017.



Australia Region

Beit Neitser

Ralf and Marie fellowshiped at Beit Neitser in Brisbane, under the leadership of Senior Pastors Craig and Glenda, since its beginnings in 2016, and served on the management committee until they were released to start the work of Derech HaMashiach on the Gold Coast. They have been truly blessed by many of the friendships that developed during their time there, and are grateful for the opportunities they had to minister and share G-d's Word at Home Group and Shul.

Ahavat Melech HaMashiach

When Mark joined the Yeshiva earlier in 2017 an instant connection developed between Ralf and Mark, and their families. Mark and Nicole, and their family, have been part of the Messianic faith for many ears, attending fellowships in Sydney that have been established for over 20 years. They are branching out with a new Kehila, Ahavat Melech HaMashiach, to reach as many people as possible and bring them to faith in the Elohim [God] of

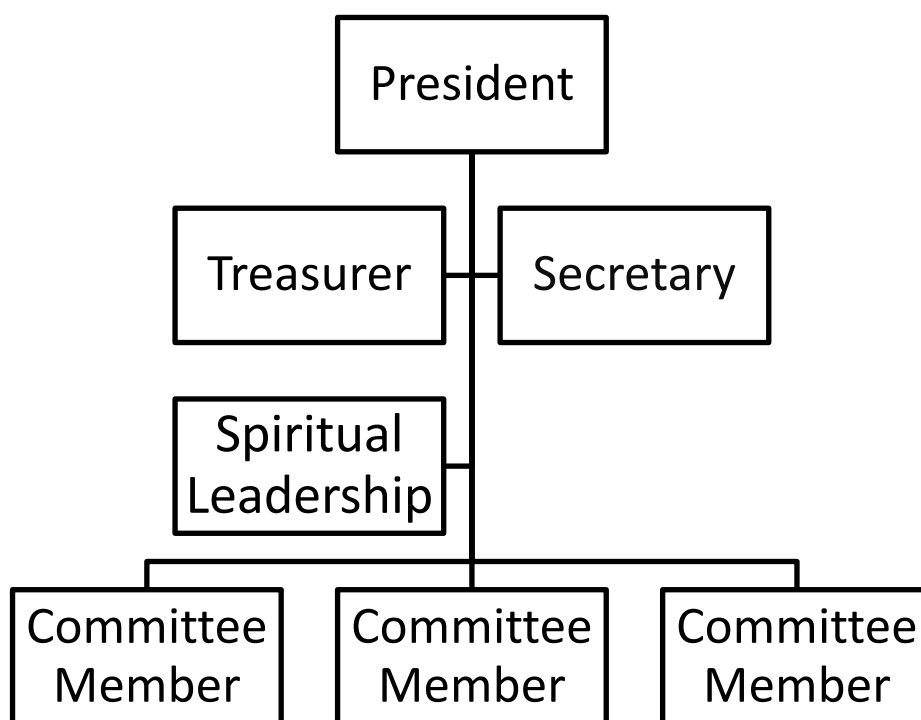


Avraham, Yitzhak and Ya'akov. While the expression of our faith may vary in a few ways, our heart is one in seeing a united Messianic Judaism, which is in unity with the Jewish people so that all of Israel may be saved and we see the return of our Rabbi, Lord and Master, the Jewish Messiah, Yeshua HaMashiach.

Structure & Management

Derech HaMashiach Inc. is registered with the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission (CANC).

Derech HaMashiach Inc. operates under a constitution or model rules for incorporated associations registered with the Department of Justice and Attorney General.



At least one member of the Spiritual Leadership Team must be elected onto the Management Committee at each annual general meeting. Currently the President and the Spiritual Leadership Team member are one and the same person, but there will come a day when there will be two separate people in these roles.

President's Report

We started 2018 with the goal to study the Book of Acts, through the lens of Judaism. We have completed the first 5 chapters, and pretty much covered many aspects that showed just how Jewish the early Messianic Community of Believers was. There are many more things we could find in the rest of the Book of Acts, but I feel we have uncovered enough for us to be able to take others through Acts and show them that Believers in Jesus, Believers in Yeshua, were originally Jewish, not just by birth, but by religion and they maintained this practice and even passed the bulk of it on to Gentile Believers in Yeshua.

Another goal was to uncover the relevance of G-d's Appointed Times, to us today, and how we can participate in their celebration, which is what we have been doing.

The third goal was around not becoming a group of people that only accumulate knowledge for the sake of knowledge, but that we would be prepared to put action to that knowledge. If our knowledge of Torah starts to disproportionately exceed our practice, then we need to stop learning and start doing what we have learnt. While studying Torah is considered one of the highest ways to worship G-d, our study needs be the means to equip us to practice and live out Torah. And so we have started doing that this year, with the start of our prayer services. But there is still much more to come in the area of practicing Torah. More planned for next year.

Charity is definitely one way that we have been practicing Torah. We will have the treasurer's report shortly, but we also gave away most of our charity income, if not in the first half of the year, but increasingly in the second half. We are providing limited support to two main charities, some sick, hungry and homeless children in Venezuela and some Holocaust survivors in Israel. In addition, we are supporting some local charity work, and have given minimal support to Bless Israel Network. Their details are in the financial report. But here as well, I think we will be able to do even more next year, as we have definitely set a good foundation already.

After our trip to Colombia in June, Marie and I came back with a bigger and more challenging vision than we ever had. While some of the things we wanted to do, like share in local churches about what is happening in Messianic Judaism around the world have not yet come to fruition, some other things have.

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Marie and I have started a fortnightly study of the week's Parsha, mainly the Gospel Readings and how they link to the Torah Parsha readings, with the Australian Yeshiva students, via Zoom. This will be opened up to anyone who joins the Yeshiva next year and will talk about that shortly. Eventually we will open that up to the Asian Yeshiva Talmidim as well, but we wanted to build the relationships in Australia first.

We also started to network with some other Messianic communities and leaders around Australia. We now have a zoom meeting every 6 weeks, with 3 other leaders. We are keeping it small initially, just those who are like minded and have a similar desire to represent authentic Messianic Judaism, not in isolation, but as a larger community. As we grow in unity, we will continue to open it up to others. But we already have plans to do some combined advertising, which we will address shortly.

In addition, we are building some relationships with Christian ministries on the Gold Coast, and other locations, that are on the same pages as we are, even if it only just on one of the corners. This is a slow work in progress, but we have 2 other ministries that meet on. Shabbat, because they have realized or been told by G-d to give Him the Shabbat back. And they are not 7th day Adventists.

We are also rebuilding relationships with some previous ministries where Marie and I have served during our Christian days.

A month or so ago, Marie and I were invited to host the Pesach service at Chuwar Baptist Church, by Elise's ex-pastor.

Last month we started Rosh Chodesh and Prayer for Israel service on new Jewish calendar month.

And lastly, Marie and I have been accepted by FFOZ to run and lead a Torah Club on the Gold Coast, or really wherever we can form a home group. This will be another avenue to bridge the gap between Christianity and Messianic Judaism, which we so desperately need, as there is such a poor understanding in most Christian churches.

So, considering this was our first year, we have managed to to cover quite a bit of ground, and been able set the foundation for some interesting developments next year.

Just a comment about quality verses quantity. I think we are all of the same heart here, that even though quantity feels good at times, and we do need to see growth next year, we will always choose quality over quantity. And I do want to say, while we have had some people come and go, and sadly one couple I would consider are not welcome back based on their actions, Marie and I are truly blessed to have all of you working with us on this endeavour. I know that you know, but this is much bigger than Marie

and I and our family (although you do make up the majority of the financial membership at the moment) and this is even bigger than all of us here. We are just so blessed to be a part of G-d's plan, regardless of how big or small our part may be.

OUR FINANCES

Who Do We Support

At Derech HaMashiach we support a number of local and overseas organisations and ministries that we have relationship with and that we know are making a difference at the grass roots level. We, at Derech HaMashiach, have pledged to ensure that 100% of all Tzedakah giving will go directly to these organisations we support. There will be no handling or transfer, or exchange fees deducted. This is fully transparent, because every year at our AGM we present the previous year's financial transactions to the membership.

Derech HaMashiach proudly support Mosaic Care, Bless Israel Network and Holocaust survivors through the "Adopt a Holocaust Survivor program" all throughout 2018.

Offerings and Tzedakah

Derech HaMashiach is a not for profit association that relies on membership fees and offerings to support this important work. We don't push tithes and offering messages, but we do teach responsible and accountable use of finances from a Torah perspective.

Tzedakah (charity) is at the heart of Messianic Judaism, it is one of the ways to express Gemilut Hasidim (Acts of loving kindness). Yeshua told us that it is better to store our treasures in heaven where neither rust nor moths can corrupt it, or thieves can steal it. The Talmud echoes His teachings on this subject.

At Derech HaMashiach we support a number of local and overseas organisations and ministries that we have relationship with and that we know are making a difference at the grass roots level. (Scroll up to see the ministries that we support). We, at Derech HaMashiach, have pledged to ensure that 100% of all Tzedakah giving will go directly to these organizations we support. There will be no handling or transfer, or exchange fees deducted. This is fully transparent, because every year Derech HaMashiach needs to have its accounts audited as an incorporated association.

International Support

Venezuela – Sick and Homeless Children (Yeshua Ministries)

As you may be aware, the political and economic situation in Venezuela is not very stable. Many of the poor are struggling to stay alive, food is extremely expensive and medication even more so, when it is available. Derech HaMashiach supports two groups, one in a rural area, near a powerful military base (the military is not pro Messianic Believers), they have limited internet, etc and food is rationed, and so any extra food for the children can cost 5 to 6 times more on the black market. Typically, the children get one solid meal every 3 to 4 days, and then some small snacks in between to sustain them to the next solid meal. The other group has the blessing of HaShem, in that they have access to be able to purchase more food at normal market price. Medication and hospital visits are what requires our support here. These children are blind or partially sighted and some also have cancer and need to get regular treatment for their ailments.



Our support helps the children get medication and medical treatment and is helping the group in the rural area invest in things that will produce ongoing food supplies like sheep and other agriculturally sustainable items.

Here are some videos of the children and some of the workers, thanking us in Australia for our support. They are working at registering a Messianic Fellowship umbrella group so that they will get some legal recognition and hopefully more support from others. Already groups in Hawaii, New Zealand, Austria and ex-Venezuelans in Australia are also supporting them, but the need is big.

The biggest need is for prayer; Protection from the authorities, and healing for the children, and a change in government from the current dictator.

Israel – Holocaust Survivors

Derech HaMashiach provides regular support for Holocaust survivors through the “Adopt a Holocaust Survivor” program operated by *Abundant Bread of Salvation*. The main goal of this ministry is to fulfil the Hebrew scripture of Isaiah 40, that says: "Comfort, comfort my people, says your God!"



All of these people are well into their 80's and many of them in their 90's, their time is short, and their strength and health is dwindling daily. Many of these precious one, must choose between putting food on their tables or buying life sustaining medications. Abundant Bread of Salvation ministry does not want them to have to make this choice. Their goal is that these survivors will live out their last days with dignity, quality of life, health, happiness and practical provision, as well as eternal life. Derech HaMashiach endeavours to support Abundant Bread of Salvation in this work.

Local Support

Mosaic Care

Mosaic Care offers financial assistance on occasion in times of crisis. At Mosaic Church, they seek to offer practical support to real needs. They recognise that life can bring emotional and financial challenges, grief or illness and through Martha's Kitchen they provide frozen meals and food to those in need.

Other Support

Bless Israel Network

Dan and his wife D'vorah, who is also a talmid of Yeshivat Shuvu, operate a ministry out of Israel called Bless Israel Network. Through its program - *Revelation to the Nations*, they are the first and only ministry in Israel providing a dedicated platform for the Israeli body of Believers to share their calling in the Land. They do this by recording interviews of the leaders in the Land and posting the interviews on their website.



Each ministry they interview is doing humanitarian work on the ground in Israel, which includes sharing about Yeshua. Their contact information is provided during the recorded interview, allowing anyone who views the program to contact them directly. Thus by blessing any interviewed ministry, Believers outside Israel can actually help build the Kingdom by virtue of the blessing provided. This is a ground-breaking ministry in Israel.

Ralf and Marie met with Dan and D'vorah while in Israel, in early 2017. They developed an instant relationship, and now Derech HaMashiach supports Bless Israel Network in this important work.

At Derech HaMashiach, we believe in working through relationship and accountability. We have relationship with Dan and D'vorah, who in turn have relationship with the people doing humanitarian work in Israel. Through this relationship, Bless Israel Network puts us in direct contact with the workers on the ground in the Land, and this establishes a level of accountability, ensuring the funds raised by Derech HaMashiach for Tzedakah go directly to these workers.

Dan and D'vorah play an important role in connecting Messianic Believers in Israel with those in Nations, working toward the goal until all Israel is saved.

Treasurer's Report

Judith Matuzelski is the current treasurer. She has an advanced diploma in accounting and has 5 years bookkeeping experience.

The bookkeeping is done using an accounting software and the bank accounts are balanced every three months. The treasurer keeps account of all the expenditures and payments together with the President.

Derech HaMashiach had eight founding members this financial year. None of the members currently take a wage or benefit financially from Derech HaMashiach.

As outlined in the Financial Reports, Derech HaMashiach aims to only use the membership fees and offerings for our expenditures ensuring that all of the Tzedakah collected are donated to the charities chosen by the members. 41.3% of the Tzedakah collected was donated to various charities in the FY 2018. 99% of the membership and offerings collected were used for the running of Derech HaMashiach with the help of a \$ 1,434.54 loan from the President and Secretary

The members have noted the cost of rent and have decided to relocate the meeting place to the Robina Community Centre in order to keep a manageable budget.

Derech HaMashiach aims to remain transparent to all members and non-members with regards to our finances.

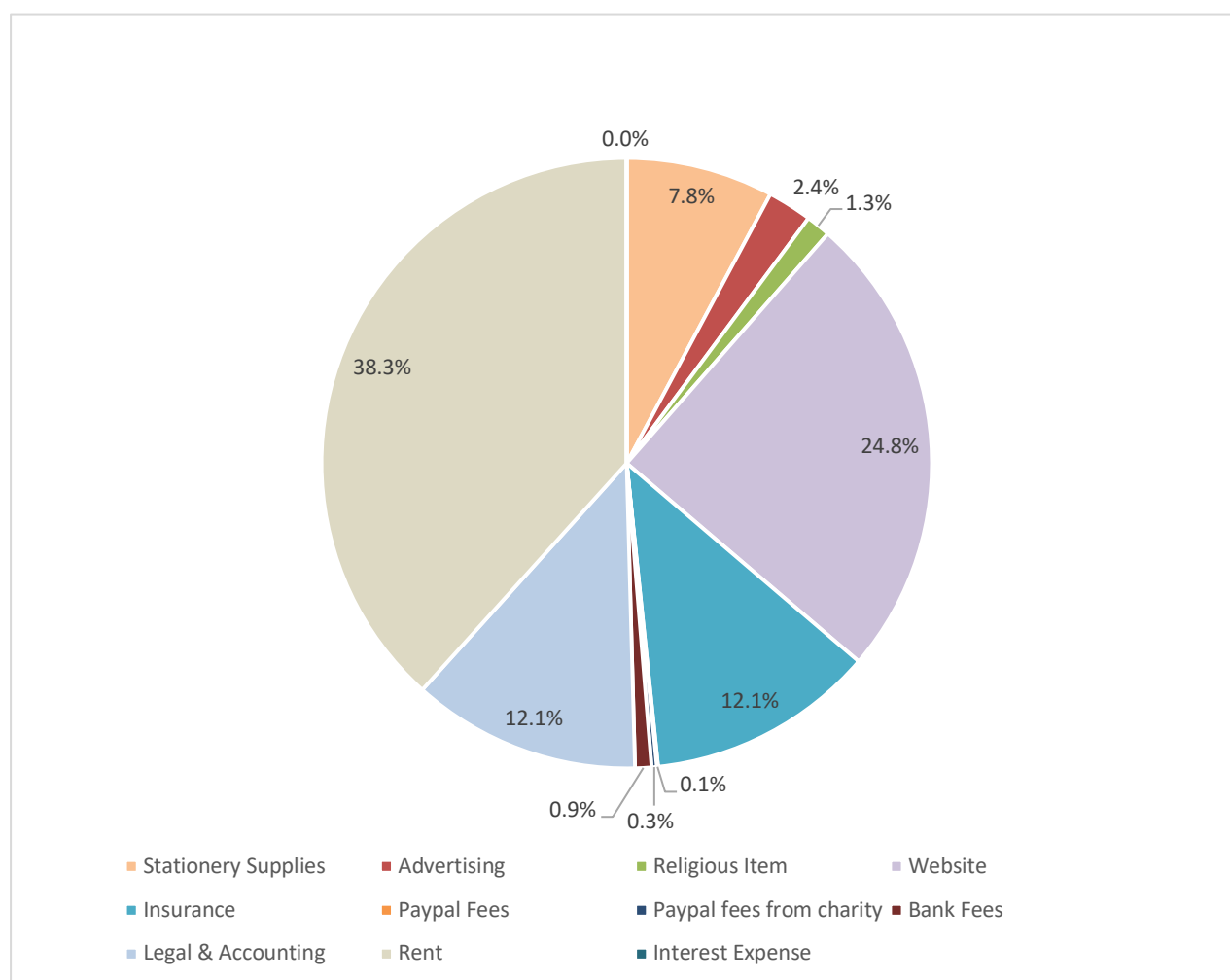


Table 1.1 Percentage distribution of offerings and membership fees

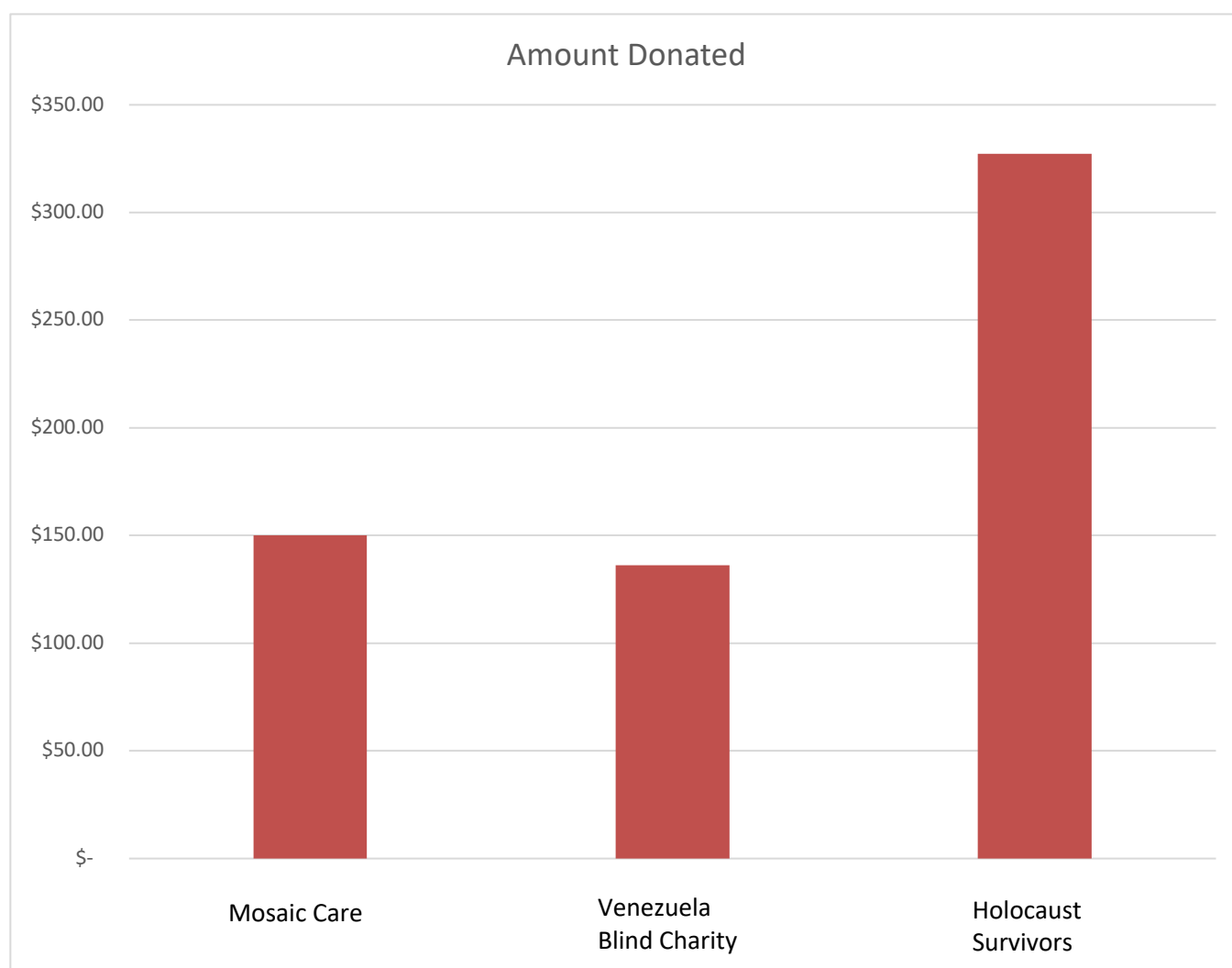

OUR FUTURE

Plans for 2019

Torah Service:

- Order of the day
 - Shacharit Prayer Service (11 - 11:45);
 - Fellowship meal (11:45 – 12:30);
 - Torah Service (12:30 – 1:40);
 - Torah Study;
 - Coffee Break (1:40 – 2:00)
 - Beit Midrash (2:00 – 3:30) (Group Yeshiva – In place of Book of Acts)

The Kosher Pastor and Yeshiva for Youth:

- Rabbi Shapira and Pastor Matt have released a series of condensed and simplified teachings on what Messianic Judaism is, mainly aimed at church pastors, called The Kosher Pastor. We hope to get this material into pastor's hands and use this to bridge the gap. We need ideas of how to do this. At the moment, it is only available by signing up to the Yeshiva, which will make it difficult to get too many pastors interested, but I am discussing the potential of releasing through DVD.
- The Yeshiva has also released a children's Yeshiva program, for age groups 5 to 13 years, which we can use once we have parents with children join us.

FFOZ Torah Club:

- Need to advertise with local churches to get exposure
- Home group material for those who are not ready to join the Beit Midrash or Shabbat Service
- Possibly run these groups in your local areas

Advertising:

- As part of the Australian Messianic Leaders Network, we are looking at placing an advertisement in the Christian magazine called "Eternity".
 - Distribution is approximately 265 churches in Brisbane metro and 41 churches in the Gold Coast.

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- Each church receives a small or large bundle consisting of 55 or 110 copies.
- Approximate reach to Brisbane metro is 60,000 individuals and to Gold Coast is 3,400 individuals.
- Cost for a small ad is \$125/month, for 6 month period (total \$750).
- The add will provide a website with map of Australia and either contact information of each fellowship and/or a link to their website if they have one.

Celebration of G-d's Appointed Times:

- Plan to hold those more purposefully next year
- Will need your help for planning and running those

Charity Support:

- Continue with Holocaust Survivors and Venezuela – increase from \$100/month
- Liberty House
 - Ministry of Lifehouse Christian Church, took over transformation house from Surf City Church. They take in addicts and then take them through a recovery program. Surf City had many issues with this ministry as it forced the addicts, whether recovered or not, to come to their church service, and you can imagine how messy that can get, to the point the Believers were feeling very unsafe, because of encounters with those who were very early on their road to recovery.
 - George Franco has taken a different approach. The participants must attend a church, not necessarily his, or a service run by the transformation house itself. Some have voluntarily attended his church and as a result have become Believers in Yeshua. He introduces them to the fellowship as recovering addicts, not addicts and everyone feels comfortable with that relationship, they all know where they stand, and there is very little trouble from those that do attend. In fact they are quite full on for Yeshua.
 - Current financial support – they have received \$4K from the local councillor and \$600 through the website. The church is having to carry the costs so far.
